All courses taken from among those listed above will be included in the calculation of the minor QCA. A student must complete all courses with a minimum 2.0 QCA for all hours attempted. In addition a minimum grade of C is required of all Foreign Language Minors in each of the required courses for the minor. Required courses may be transferred only with the approval of the Chair of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures. Authorization to take coursework elsewhere should be obtained beforehand from the Dean's Office and the Head of the Department of Foreign Languages and Literatures.

N.B.

(1) Classics 2444 (= Eng 2444 and Hum 2444) and Classics 2454 (= Eng 2454 and Hum 2454) do not count toward a Latin Minor.

(2) There is a maximum of 8 hours of Independent Study.

(3) No course required for the Latin Minor may be taken Pass/Fail.
