

THE MEGAN E. CHRISTENSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Megan E. Christenson Memorial Scholarship was created to honor the life of former Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University double major (French and Communication) Megan Christenson and is awarded to a Virginia Tech student from one of those majors in alternating years. French majors are eligible in even-numbered years; Communication majors in odd-numbered years.

Requirements:

- have completed 15 hours at Virginia Tech
- be a French or Communication major
- have a minimum 3.0 GPA in major and overall

Restrictions:

- students found guilty of an Honor Code violation are not eligible
- past recipients of the scholarship are not eligible

Provide a personal statement of no more than 500 words on a separate sheet that explains how your major fits into your life goals. If appropriate, include a short statement addressing your financial aid needs.
